SCHOOL'S TRANSPORTATION RULES

Free transportation is provided for children living in the Highland Park/Highwood School District #112 over 1.5 miles from school or for children living on a hazardous route who are under 1.5 miles from school.

Children must board at the designated stops.

The school reserves the right to deny the use of the bus to students who violate bus rules. Bus rules will be discussed with the students early in the year.

Instructions to School Bus Riders

In order to provide safety to all rides of Highland Park/Highwood School District #112 buses, the following rules must be enforced:

1. Proper behavior is expected of students at the bus stop. Stay off the road, but be visible to the bus driver. Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before attempting to board the bus.
2. Students shall be absolutely quiet when approaching and crossing railroad tracks.
3. The driver is in charge at all times children are on the bus, including emergency situations.
4. In the interest of student safety, the following shall be observed:
 - *Nothing shall be placed in the aisles or out the window.
 - *Quiet talking only with your seat partner.
 - *Hands and feet shall be kept to yourself.
 - *Treat school property and all people with respect.
 - *Nothing should be thrown inside of the bus or out of bus windows.
5. Observe safety precautions at pickup and drop off points. Where it is necessary to cross the road, proceed to a point at least 10 feet in front of the bus on the right shoulder of the road where traffic may be observed in both directions. Wait for a signal from the bus driver permitting you to cross.
